- 2) Translational research (Scientific disciplinary sector: MED/04; MED/50; AGR/15; VET/04)

**Procedures for admission to the ordinary competition:**

The verification procedures are carried out pursuant to Article 6 letter A.

The selection will take place through an evaluation based on qualifications, a written test and an oral test with discussion of a research project concerning the topics of the doctoral course (between 1,500 and 2,000 words), previously sent by the candidate together with the admission application, **under penalty of exclusion.**

The oral exam will focus on the discussion of the research project in relation to its originality, methodological rigor and consistency with the research lines of the doctorate. Knowledge of the English language will also be verified as part of the oral exam.

The exams will be distinguished for each curriculum and the respective rankings will merge into a single final ranking that will entitle access. The positions available will be assigned, among the various curricula, according to the order in the merit ranking, until the positions are exhausted. Positions that have not been assigned due to lack of suitable candidates in a curriculum, will be assigned to candidates found to be suitable for other curricula, based on the score obtained in the general ranking. Candidates must indicate the choice of curriculum, **under penalty of exclusion from the competition.**

**Methods for completing the tests in English for foreign candidates:**

Foreign candidates can choose to take the selections in Italian or English.

Evaluation of qualifications: 27 July 2021, 9:30 am;

Oral exam: 03 August 2021, 9:30 am.
